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Enigmacursor, new species discovery

David Aaron is proud to announce the sale of a newly identified dinosaur species to the Natural History Museum, London. Initially identified as a *Nanosaurus*, this exceptional Late Jurassic skeleton has since been reclassified as a previously unknown species and genus, an *Enigmacursor*, which means “the enigmatic runner.” Excavated in 2021–22 in Colorado, the fossil attracted attention for its completeness, detail and size leading to the Museum's researchers to make the new discovery. The fossil is on display in the Museum's Earth Hall.
