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Juliasaurus

A 154-million-year-old Late Jurassic predator, sold by David Aaron to a private collector, is on display for the first time at the Hollytrees Museum in Essex. Nicknamed 'Juliasaurus', the specimen is one of the most important North American dinosaur fossil discoveries in recent years and represents the potential to discover a new species. The gallery has facilitated the loan to Hollytrees Museum which will coincide with the first opportunity to conduct research on the fossil.
