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Pachycephalosaurus Skull

An extraordinarily rare skull of *Pachycephalosaurus*, the ‘thick-skulled lizard’, which lived around 65-68 million years ago in the late Cretaceous period of North America, alongside some of the most iconic dinosaurs such as *Tyrannosaurus* and *Triceratops*. It is known from only one species, *P. wyomingensis*, the adult forms of which are only known from skull remains.
